Phishing emails The national cybersecurity team has been receiving reports of emails, sent to personal accounts (e.g., Gmail) claiming to be from Chief Executives. The recipients typically have a LinkedIn profile with their current workplace specified. It is likely the attackers are using recent data leaks to get the LinkedIn profile email address. If you receive an email like this, please report to the cybersecurity team (gram.infosecurity@nhs.scot) and report the email as phishing via your provider.

Pilot launched to diagnose blood-borne viruses A pilot scheme, aimed at diagnosing blood-borne viruses (BBVs) earlier and improve outcomes and treatment options for patients, is now underway in the Emergency Department at ARI. Early detection of Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C and HIV can be lifesaving, allowing treatment to start promptly. In a national first, everyone who has a blood test performed as part of their assessment at ED will be tested for BBVs. The ability to opt-out has been built into the pilot programme.
