Here is the brief for Thursday 25 November 2021.

Tests of Change The NHS Grampian Organisational Change policy is currently under review. While that work is ongoing, interim guidance is being issued for tests of change.

• What is a Test of Change? Tests of Change involve testing ideas on a small scale and building knowledge incrementally. The aims of the test of change should be clearly defined and a timeframe identified. A test of change does not equate to Organisational Change. However, where the test of change could potentially impact upon terms and conditions, it should be managed in accordance with the principles of Organisational Change and the Staff Governance Standard and as a minimum, led by a Project Group with Line Management, HR, and Partnership representation. If a test of change after evaluation is successful, Organisational Change is required to adopt the successful change within the System and to ensure that the service improvement is sustainable.


