This offers us a more adaptable intranet where people have more opportunities to manage their own content. Content owners and webmasters will be contacted to help with the process in due course. When contacted, we will need your help with identifying all content, making sure that it is current and for you to verify any content to be migrated is still relevant and correct.

Migrating the entire intranet is a significant undertaking and will take months to complete. Over this period, the process and schedule will be shared as we work with each department and find its content owners and webmasters.
